

County Commissioners Meeting
January 24, 2022

Lee Doolen called the meeting to order at 9:03 a.m. Commissioners Munson and Miller were also present. Doolen led flag salute, Don Sporleder led us in prayer.

Munson made a motion to approve the January 3, January 6 and January 19, 2022 Minutes with typo in paragraph 14 to read District #3 on the January 3, 2022 Minutes. Motion seconded by Miller. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.
