Lincoln County Road Crossing/Paralleling Petition, Floodplain Determination & Fee Schedule

NON-REFUNDABLE FEE SCHEDULE:

- 1. Permit for Road Crossing/Paralleling Fee: \$300/crossing plus \$300/section line or portion thereof for paralleling. (Permanent or temporary crossing in the right-of-way)
- 2. Installation Without a Permit Fee: \$1,000 plus any applicable costs and damages
- 3. Public Utilities Permit Fee: \$25.00 Flood Plain Determination Only Includes Gas, Electric, Telephone, Water, Rural Water
- 4. Floodplain Determination Application Fee: \$25.00
 - Required with all road crossing permits.
- 5. Variance Filing with the Board of County Commissioners Fee: \$25.00

RESPONSIBILITY FOR DAMAGES AND LIABILITY

The applicant (contractor, company, or individual) is solely responsible for any washouts, degradation, or damage to county roads, ditches, and other drainage infrastructure resulting from their activities, including but not limited to road crossings, equipment operation, or failure to adequately restore the area. The applicant shall hold the County harmless for all damages. The applicant or their insurance provider shall bear full liability for any accidents, injuries, or property damage that occur as a result of the road crossing, equipment operation, or improper repair or restoration of the affected area. All work must meet County standards, and final approval is subject to inspection by the Floodplain Administrator or designated official.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- 1. Construction must start within 90 days of permit approval, or a new permit will be required.
- 2. New permits are required for repairs or alterations to permanently installed lines.
- 3. For multiple crossings (3 or more), submit one full set including a county map marking all crossings, legal descriptions, road names, and total fees. Permits are issued for single line crossings. If an original copy is needed, submit two copies; otherwise, a photocopy will be returned.
- 4. All road crossings must be bored unless written approval from the County Commissioner is obtained and attached to the permit request.
- 5. The applicant agrees to hold Lincoln County harmless for any damages or injuries related to the construction, maintenance, or operation of facilities within the county right-of-way.
- 6. Contractors must adhere to all federal and state statutes, rules, regulations, and safety codes.

Temporary Utility Permit Petition - Road Crossing/Paralleling

CONSTRUCTION MUST BEGIN WITHIN 90 DAYS OF PERMIT APPROVAL

Fees:

Rules for Installation:

- Lines paralleling the road must be placed as close to the right-of-way line farthest from the road as possible, avoiding barrow ditches.
- Lines crossing culverts must not obstruct more than 10% of the culvert's flow.
- All lines must be installed and maintained at least 2 feet below the surface of the road, barrow ditches, and to the right-of-way line farthest from the road unless otherwise approved by the County Commissioners.
- Lines must be tagged at both ends, displaying the permit holder's name, contact information, and installation date. For lines longer than one mile, tags must be placed at each mile.

Permit Expiration:

This permit expires 90 days after approval. Any lines placed in the right-of-way after 90 days must be removed unless a renewal is obtained. *Renewal costs* \$300.00 per additional 30 days.

Responsibilities of the Permit Holder:

- •Traffic management during installation, repair, and maintenance.
- Any required lowering, modification, or relocation of the line must be done at the permit holder's expense, without claims against the County.
- •Damage to lines during roadwork must be repaired at the permit holder's expense.

Conditions of Use:

- Permit holders must use only designated county roads and adhere to weight limits and "No Through Trucks" restrictions.
- Non-compliance may result in permit revocation and refusal of future permits.

Liability:

Permit holders assume all liability for any damage caused by the line and agree to reimburse the County for any repairs to roads, culverts, bar ditches, or any other property. Permit holders agree to hold the County harmless from any and all claims and actions, litigation or damages arising out of the construction, erection, installation, removal, maintenance, or operation of its property from the negligence of the permit holder's employees/contractors in the operation thereof.

All work in the right-of-way is subject to inspection and approval by the Board of County Commissioners. All fees must be paid to the Lincoln County Commissioners, 811 Manvel, Suite 4, Chandler, OK 74834.

The Board reserves the right to waive processing and inspection fees if deemed necessary.

Installation Requirements:

- Location Guidelines:
 - When paralleling a roadway, the utility line must be placed no more than six (6) feet from the right-of-way (R-O-W) line farthest from the road.
 - o If this is not possible, an alternate route must be submitted in writing with the utility permit for possible approval.
- Burial Depth Requirements:
 - O Service Lines (Underground): Must be buried and maintained at a minimum depth of six (6) feet below the lowest point of the R-O-W throughout its entire path.
 - Transmission Lines (Larger than Service Lines): Must be buried and maintained at a minimum depth of twelve (12) feet below the lowest point of the R-O-W throughout the entire length.
- Material and Encasing:
 - All poly lines must be fully encased throughout the R-O-W.
 - O All buried electric lines must be encased in metal conduit from pole to pole.
 - O Electric lines must comply with NESC and NEC specifications.
- Installation Method for Roads with Permanent Surface:
 - Lines must be bored under the roadway (trenching is not allowed in these cases).
 - If trenching is used:
 - Trench must be **backfilled in 8" lifts**, compacted with mechanical tampers.
 - Compaction must reach 95% of Standard Proctor maximum density of the subgrade.
 - Resurfacing must be the same type and twice the thickness of the original surface.
- Additional Requirements:
 - A profile sheet is available upon request.
 - The **Board of County Commissioners may grant written variances**, but no variance can be less restrictive than the original permit.

Responsibility and Liability:

Petitioners agree to assume all responsibility for handling traffic during the construction, repair and maintenance of this line. Should any lowering, modification or relocation of the line be required in the operation of the road work, said lowering, modification or relocation shall be made by the undersigned petitioners or their successors in ownership of the line within 60 days of written notification, without claim against the County. Should any damage to the line occur in the operation of the road work, said damage shall be repaired by the petitioners or their successors, without claim against the County.

Petitioners assume all liability for any damage caused by the line and agree to reimburse the County for any repairs to roads, culverts, bar ditches, or any other property. Petitioners agree to hold the County harmless from any and all claims and actions, litigation or damages arising out of the construction, erection, installation, removal, maintenance, or operation of its property from the negligence of the Petitioners' employees/contractors in the operation thereof.
