

County Commissioners Special Meeting
October 4, 2021

Lee Doolen called the meeting to order at 9:08 a.m. Commissioners Munson and Miller were also present.

Flag Salute was led by Lee Doolen and prayer was led by Don Sporleder.

Munson made a motion to approve minutes from the September 7 and September 20, 2021 meetings. Motion seconded by Miller. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

Munson made a motion to approve a Bureau of Indian Affairs Agreement (BIA) for the replacement of 30 bridges in Lincoln County. The 30 Bridge Project will span over a period of four years and will include all three districts. Motion seconded by Miller. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.
