

County Commissioner's Meeting
November 21st, 2022

Lee Doolen called the meeting to order at 9:04 a.m. Carl Munson was also present. Marlon Miller was absent.

Will Fine led prayer and Lee Doolen led flag salute.

Munson made a motion to approve minutes from the November 7th, 2022 meetings. Motion seconded by Miller. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

Miller made a motion to enter Executive Session for the following items:

- A. Pursuant to 25 O.S., Section 307(B)(4), for the purpose of confidential communications between the Board and its attorney regarding selecting the law firms of Fulmer Sill and Frantz Law Group, APLC to serve as counsel for the county in litigation involving E-Cigarettes for the Marketing, Sales Practices & Products Liability which has caused harm to the county. Attorneys from the law firms of Fulmer Sill will be present via phone to provide advice and information. Public disclosure of these confidential communications would seriously impair the ability of the Board and its attorney to properly assess any potential litigation. As such, the communications in this Executive Session are confidential.
- B. Pursuant to 25 O.S., Section 307(B)(3) to discuss the purchase of real property.

Doolen made a motion to exit Executive Session and return to Open Meeting. Motion seconded by Miller. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

No action was taken to pass Resolution related to Executive Session identified above for the selection of Fulmer Sill and Frantz Law Group, APLC to serve as counsel for the county in litigation involving E-Cigarettes for the Marketing, Sales Practices & Products Liability which has caused harm to the county.

Doolen made a motion to authorize Marlon Miller to negotiate purchase of real estate at amount discussed in Executive Session. Motion seconded by Munson. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

Commissioners opened Bid # 23-04 for Digital Ballots. The following bids were received:

Munson made a motion to award the bid to Midwest Printing due to the better quality of the product. Motion seconded by Miller. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

The Sales Tax Advisory Committee requested that 2% of the Sales Tax be moved from the Commissioners for Roads and Bridges to the Fire Departments. They also requested that the overage from the OSU Extension Office be split between Industrial Development and the Fire Departments. Doolen requests that everything remains the same. Miller made a motion to give overage from the OSU Extension Office to Economic Development and leave everything else the same. Motion seconded by Munson. Munson and Miller voted aye. Doolen voted nay.

Miller made a motion to table Item #11 to approve a new Access Control System for the courthouse. Motion seconded by Munson. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

No action was taken to approve a Cyber Security Plan for the courthouse. It will be discussed more in depth when more information is available.

Miller made a motion to approve the Emergency Response Procedures for Lincoln County Courthouse. Motion seconded by Munson. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

Commissioners discussed plan to replace street and road signs.
