Minutes will be in order as each item was discussed.

Commissioner Lee Doolen called the meeting to order at 9:03 a.m. Commissioners Marlon Miller and Will Fine were also present.

Fine led the prayer and Doolen led the flag salute.

No Citizen Comments.

Miller made a motion to approve the December 1, 2025 meeting minutes. Motion seconded by Fine. Doolen, Miller and Fine all voted aye.

Commissioners gave an update on OSU Extension office construction with a possible move in date of January 1, 2026 so no rent would be required for January. Cody Linker will be going Friday December 19th to start cleaning out the rental and move equipment. Internet was set up in the new building on December 16th. The Chamber of Commerce has suggested a ribbon cutting that Doolen would like to do in the Spring.

Miller made a motion to approve **Resolution #25-212** for erosion control improvement currently underway at the Lincoln County OSU Extension. The amount of \$15,000.00 will be transferred to provide wall blocks and gravel to redirect water and prevent wash outs. Motion seconded by Doolen. Doolen, Miller and Fine all voted aye.

Fine made a motion to approve **Resolution #25-213** for refund request from Lincoln County Citizens Alliance who provided a total of \$1,700.00 for two planned mailings of the Public Notice regarding Wind Turbines. The first donation of \$1,000.00 had a remaining balance of \$98.80 and the second donation of \$700.00 remained unspent due to cancellation request by Lincoln County Citizens Alliance. The total refund being \$798.80. Motion seconded by Miller. Doolen, Miller and Fine all voted aye.

Fine made a motion to award Bid #26-06 6-month bids. Award tally sheet can be viewed in the Lincoln County Clerk's office. Motion seconded by Miller. Doolen, Miller and Fine all voted aye.

Fine made a motion to approve Section 33 Estates Plat in District #1. Motion seconded by Miller. Doolen, Miller and Fine.

Sheriff Kevin Garrett gave jail renovation project update and is hoping to be complete by April with being able to start moving inmates out soon. Overall, the project is going well, and the Investigators were moved over.

Doolen made a motion to accept the 2025 Sheriff Assistance Grant award of \$300,000.00. Motion seconded by Fine. Doolen, Miller and Fine all voted aye.

No action regarding Carbon Capture Pipelines.

No action regarding Indigent cremation due to State Statute not being met.

No action at this time regarding Oklahoma Gas & Electric (OG&E) staging at the Fairgrounds during emergency power outages.

Fine made a motion to reappoint Jack Vaughn to the Lincoln County Industrial Board. Motion seconded by Miller. Doolen, Miller and Fine all voted aye.

Doolen made a motion to approve **Resolution #25-214** for District #1 2025 Chevrolet Silverado purchase. The purchase price will be \$48,861.00 from the Equipment Revolving Fund with the required 5% of \$2,443.05 contributed to the fund. Motion seconded by Miller. Doolen, Miller and Fine all voted aye.

Doolen made a motion to approve District #3 Oklahoma Unpaved Roads Grant application in the amount of \$63,103.42 for 750 Rd. between 3310 and 3330 Rd. The estimated project cost is \$126,206.85. The remaining funds in the amount of \$63,103.43 will be provided by the county. Motion seconded by Miller. Doolen, Miller and Fine all voted aye.

Miller made a motion to approve Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT) Claim Form 324a for the amount of \$7,504.00 for fencing project in District #3. Motion seconded by Fine. Doolen, Miller and Fine all voted aye.

Miller made a motion to approve Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT) Federal Emergency Relief Project Damage Statement for \$64,688.58. Motion seconded by Fine. Doolen, Miller and Fine all voted aye.

No action regarding Access Drive Permit Policy Resolution.

Miller made a motion to approve account number amendment to **Resolution #25-137**. Motion seconded by Fine. Doolen, Miller and Fine voted aye.

No action at this time regarding Civic Plus for agenda management software. The Commissioners would like to see a presentation of the software at the January 20th Commissioner meeting.

Wagnon gave an overview of remaining Opioid Abatement Settlement Funds in the amount of \$17,196.46. She reported that at this time only one more invoice would be submitted by Gateway to Prevention for the Equine Therapy program. She also reported on the Attorney General Opioid Abatement Grant funds in the amount of \$150,000 for Fiscal Year 26.

Miller made a motion to approve Girl Power/Wise Guys expenses on April 7, 2026 to be paid from the Opioid Abatement Settlement. Last year it cost around \$6,000.00 for lunches and shirts and expecting around the same cost. Motion seconded by Fine. Doolen, Miller and Fine all voted aye.

Miller made a motion to enter Executive Session pursuant to 25 O.S. § 307 (B)(3) for discussing the purchase or appraisal of real property for Lincoln County. As such, the communications in this Executive Session are confidential. Motion seconded by Fine. Doolen, Miller and Fine all voted aye.

Doolen made a motion to exit Executive Session and reconvene to open meeting. Motion seconded by Miller. Doolen, Miller and Fine all voted aye.

Fine made a motion to authorize Marlon Miller to represent the Board of County Commissioners to negotiate a purchase price for real property as discussed in Executive Session. Motion seconded by Miller. Doolen, Miller and Fine all voted aye.
