Commissioner Lee Doolen called the meeting to order at 11:03 A.M. Commissioner Will Fine was also present. Marlon Miller was absent.

Fine led the prayer and Doolen led the Flag.

Citizen's Comments: Agra Superintendent Jeff Kelly discussed the 2,727,278.00 USDA Community Facilities Grant program they were applying for and would like to have a support letter signed by the county at the next meeting.

Fine made a motion to approve Fallis Fire Department's Slip-On Unit grant application for 3 new units. Motion seconded by Doolen. Doolen and Fine both voted aye.

HUB International introduced themselves as a potential future broker for the county. They are looking into the county being able to use Blue Cross Blue Shield without OPEH&W. The county has been unable to get their data from OPEH&W but Blue Cross Blue Shield has said Lincoln was not the only county having that problem and they are willing to work with HR Generalist Melanie McFee with a census. HUB will get numbers from Blue Cross Blue Shield along with other insurance companies for comparison and bring it back before the Commissioners in 2-3 weeks. There are no preexisting conditions, and all employees will have full coverage on day 1. HUB will also be looking into lower deductibles. HR Generalist Melanie McFee stated that HUB has been easy to work with and been very responsive.

Doolen made a motion to reject all bids for Bid #26-10 Used Grader-JD672G for District #2. Motion seconded by Fine. Doolen and Fine both voted aye.

Fine made a motion to approve **Resolution #26-50** Sheriff office donation of a 2024 GMC Sierra 2500 extended cab pickup from Steve Orr. Motion seconded by Doolen. Doolen and Miller both voted aye.

Fine made a motion to approve contract between Treasurer office and Smith Brothers Abstract. Motion seconded by Doolen. Doolen and Fine both voted aye.

Fine made a motion to pay \$4,000.00 from each District out of Use Tax to rent dumpsters for spring cleanup. Motion seconded by Doolen. Doolen and Fine both voted aye.

CED4 provided the Commissioners with a chart to show projection numbers for the CBRI projects. The Commissioners will speak to the Tribes to see if they can assist with any bridge cost to help budget cost. They will reassign \$1.2 million to the end of the project and keep the plan as is for now.

Fine made a motion to approve claims. Motion seconded by Doolen. Doolen and Fine both voted aye.
