

County Commissioners Meeting
March 22, 2021

Lee Doolen called the meeting to order at 9:08 A.M. Commissioners Munson and Miller were also present.

Flag Salute was led by Lee Doolen and prayer was led by Don Sprieder.

Miller made a motion to approve the minutes from the March 1, 2021 Commissioner meeting. Motion seconded by Munson. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

No action was taken to award Bid #21-01 for new motor graders.

Commissioners discussed holding a special election to impose a ¾¢ sales tax for the construction of a new jail and to enhance ambulance service. If the election passes in June, the taxes will become effective in October 2021. The ambulance service would start receiving their portion in December 2021 or January 2022. Commissioner Miller asked if the sales tax would be enough to sustain a county-wide ambulance service. Doolen responded that the money was meant to subsidize to help take the strain off the existing services. Miller would like to explore options to see about adding ambulance service to the county instead of just subsidizing. The Commissioners discussed putting together a Board consisting of representatives from local municipalities, Fire Departments, 911, and Ambulance District to determine a cost analysis of ambulance service, to gather information and to put together a program for the use of County Sales Tax to enhance ambulance service. The Commissioners would like to schedule a special meeting on March 29 and invite potential Board members for discussion on this matter. Miller made a motion to table this matter until March 29th. Motion seconded by Munson. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

Doolen made a motion to approve a CDBG Revitalization Grant Application resolution, Citizen Participation Plan, Disclosure, Leverage document, Certification and all other related documents for a CDBG Grant application for fire equipment for the Arlington Fire Department. Motion seconded by Miller. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

Munson made a motion to approve a Resolution declaring April as Fair Housing month. Motion seconded by Miller. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

Munson made a motion to approve a Fair Housing Proclamation for Lincoln County. Motion seconded by Miller. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

No action was taken to go into Executive Session.

No action was taken to renew a lease agreement for property located in the NE/4 of 28-15N-4E for the purpose of maintaining a radio tower.

Munson made a motion to approve a Resolution Appointing, Requesting, Receiving Inventory Officers for the Nutrition Site Joint Account. Alicia Wagnon will be the Requesting Officer. The Receiving Officer will be each nutrition sites own receiving officer. Motion seconded by Miller. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

No action was taken to approve an agreement between the Lincoln County Health Department and Falco Alarm system.

No action was taken to apply for a USDA grant to install a sprinkler system at the Fairgrounds. The grant will cover up to \$55,000, but a quote for the sprinkler system was over \$140,000.00. Additional funds would be needed to cover the cost of the project.

Miller made a motion to begin the bid process on county owned property located at Lot #13, Pecan Meadows in District #2. Motion seconded by Munson. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

Miller made a motion to approve Resolution #21-13, Declaration of Surplus in the Sheriff's Office for a 2010 Dodge Charger, Inventory #B-331.18, VIN 2B3AA4CT5AH217573. Motion seconded by Munson. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

Miller made a motion to approve Resolution #21-16 authorizing reimbursement to the Inmate Medical Fund from Stroud Medical Center. Motion seconded by Munson. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

The Commissioners discussed the Road Specification Resolution from 1995. They will review it and make recommendations for change at a later meeting.

No action was taken at this time to increase assistance from Use Tax Funds to aid in Commissioner's Equipment lease payments. A Use Tax Resolution will be drawn up at a later time to be discussed for approval for Fiscal Year 2021-2022.

County Facilities Manager, Virgil Wilson reported to the Commissioners on his inspections of county facilities.

Emergency Management Director, Wendi Marcy reported that Emergency Management will be holding an open house on Saturday, April 10 from 11:00 – 3:00 at the Courthouse.
