

County Commissioners Meeting
April 19, 2021

Lee Doolen called the meeting to order at 9:06 A.M. Commissioners Munson and Miller were also present.

Flag Salute was led by Lee Doolen and prayer was led by Don Sporleder.

Miller made a motion to approve the minutes from the April 5, 2021 Commissioner meeting with the following changes:

Under Resolution Second Amendment to Road Specifications, remove 9) and add "10) Add: In addition, any new or existing developments shall be 80% occupied prior to consideration of road acceptance by the Board of County Commissioners."

Motion seconded by Munson. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

Munson made a motion to approve the amendment of Landmark Trail III plat by vacating Penny Lane and replat Penny Lane as Lot 34A. Motion seconded by Miller. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

Miller made a motion to approve an engineering contract with EST for the replacement of Bridges 175-D2, 183-D2 and 239-D2. Motion seconded by Munson. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

Miller made a motion to approve Resolution #21-20 authorizing the use of CBRI funds to pay the engineering fees in the amount of \$150,500.00 on the above mentioned Bridge Projects. Motion seconded by Munson. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

Miller made a motion to accept the 6year plan as provided by Circuit Engineering District #4 Daniel Clement. Motion seconded by Munson. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

Munson made a motion to approve a Special Election to form a 522 Ambulance District with a 3 mil levy, that if the proposal passes, will supplement existing ambulance services at this time and creates flexibility to adjust with changes to ambulance service over time. Motion seconded by Miller. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

Miller made a motion to engage Floyd Law Firm, P.C. to act as special counsel to the County in connection with the calling and holding of the July 13, 2021 special election. Motion seconded by Munson. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

No action was taken to authorize District #2 to purchase a CAT Excavator.

Miller made a motion to approve Donation Resolution #21-21 to accept a 10,000 gallon water tanker from Osage County. Motion seconded by Munson. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

Munson made a motion to allow Wilson, Dotson and Associates to prepare Temporary Appropriations at 50% for Fiscal Year 2021-2022. Motion seconded by Miller. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

Miller made a motion to approve Resolution #21-22, declaring the 2015 Cat Grader 140M3, Serial # ON9D00454, acquired on 1/27/16 for \$259,830.00 as surplus in District #2. Motion seconded by Munson. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

Miller made a motion to approve Resolution # 21-23 to dispose of the above equipment by returning the grader to Warren Cat. Motion seconded by Munson. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

Miller made a motion to approve the Transcript of Proceedings for the sale of county property located at Lot #13 of Pecan Meadows in District #2. Motion seconded by Munson. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

Miller made a motion to approve a County Deed for the county property located at Lot #13 of Pecan Meadows in District #2. Motion seconded by Munson. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

Miller made a motion to approve SEFA reports for Fiscal Year 2019 and 2020. Motion seconded by Munson. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.
