Commissioner Lee Doolen called the meeting to order at 9:05 a.m. Commissioners Marlon Miller and Will Fine were also present.

Fine led the prayer and Doolen led the flag salute.

No Citizen Comments.

Miller made a motion to approve the April 9, 2026 and April 16, 2026 meeting minutes. Motion seconded by Fine. Doolen, Miller and Fine all voted aye.

Regina Riley addressed the Commissioners regarding the possibility of passing a moratorium against data centers. Doolen stated that the County does not have the ability due to lack of state statute. It was asked about passing a temporary Agriculture zoning. ADA Stacey Bateman Woods stated that would require more research and has no knowledge of it being done in any other counties. DEQ and other State departments are there to protect rural county properties. Doolen stated the need to have a legislature get a bill approved in order to give the Commissioners the ability to make the best decisions as Commissioners on this matter. As a commissioner he doesn't get to have an opinion. Regina Riley thanked Marlon for his notes from the Geronimo call and asked the Commissioners to represent both sides when speaking to citizens regarding data centers.

Sonny Johnston addressed the Commissioners regarding his farm located on 770 Rd. He showed before and after photos his road and property line and discussed his concern of losing property due to the grading. Fine stated he will get over to look at it and get it fixed up.
