Commissioner Lee Doolen called the meeting to order at 10:01 A.M. Commissioners Marlon Miller and Will Fine were also present.

Fine led the prayer and Doolen led the Flag.

No Citizen Comments.

With the change of insurance from OPEH&W to HUB International Blue Cross Blue Shield plans, all retirees will no longer be covered by OPEH&W. All retirees aged 65 and older will have a second enrollment at the end of May for Medicare. The Commissioners discussed the option of subsidizing insurance for retirees aged 65 and under. They were unable to see how we could afford this option after reviewing multiple ideas. No Action was taken.

Judy Smith updated the Commissioners on the Comprehensive, Opioid, Stimulant and Substance Use Program (COSSUP) grant application that was approved in February. The 3-year grant for \$1 million dollars was submitted yesterday. If approved the county would hire Judy as a county employee with 75.2% of her salary along with benefits paid by the grant. The remainder of her salary and benefits would be covered by the Opioid grant with no cost to the county. The COSSUP grant is treatment and recovery focused and will help address the cycles of addiction and mental health. The grant will provide a Behavioral Health specialist in the jail for daily assessments. It will also provide a liaison for individuals with a history of substance abuse or mental health. All inpatient services will be covered by the grant and provide services during jail and after they are released.

Doolen made a motion to approve **Resolution #26-76** District #2 2026 Unpaved Road project account set up along with **Resolution #26-77** District #3 2026 Unpaved Road project account set up. Motion seconded by Miller, Doolen, Miller and Fine all voted aye.

Miller made a motion to approve the following:

Transfer of Appropriations

- \$358,831.10 transferred from CBRI to Dist 2 26 Unpaved Rd.
- \$105,103.90 transferred from CBRI to Dist 3 26 Unpaved Rd.

Transfer of Funds

- Adjustment to Disbursements \$90.30 from Sheriff M&O to Sheriff's Assistance Grant.

Motion seconded by Fine, Doolen, Miller and Fine all voted aye.

Fine made a motion to adjourn. Motion was seconded by Miller, Doolen, Miller and Fine all voted aye. Meeting adjourned at 10:48 A.M.
