

County Commissioners Special Meeting  
June 21, 2021

Lee Doolen called the meeting to order at 9:12 A.M. Members Carl Munson and Marlon Miller were also present.

Flag Salute was led by Lee Doolen and prayer was led by Will Fine.

Miller made a motion to approve the June 7<sup>th</sup> Commissioner meeting. Motion seconded by Munson. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

Commissioners reviewed bid tabulations for six month bids for rock, lumber and other related items. Miller made a motion to award the bids as discussed during the review. Motion seconded by Munson. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye. The awarded bid list is available for review in the Lincoln County Clerk's Office.

Miller made a motion to approve the \$40,000.00 TASC Contract. Motion seconded by Munson. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

Munson made a motion to approve the Absentee Shawnee Tribe of Oklahoma Subgrant Agreement and Subawards Policies and Procedures. Motion seconded by Miller. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye. Engineer Don Russell informed the Commissioners that Truman Carter is putting a request in to Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) for a multi bridge replacement project in Lincoln County.

Miller made a motion to approve a Reimbursement Resolution for the Lincoln County Election Board for Fiscal Year 2022. Motion seconded by Munson. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

Miller made a motion to declare June 21<sup>st</sup> as Jimmy Day Day. Motion seconded by Munson. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

Miller made a motion to schedule a special meeting on Wednesday, June 30 at 9:00 a.m. Motion seconded by Munson. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

At 10:00 a.m., Doolen announced that the meeting would resume at 10:10 in the Courthouse Lobby for a public forum.

At 10:10, Doolen thanked participants for coming and turned the meeting over to Sheriff Dougherty. Discussion was held in regards to the new jail project and election ballot. Sheriff Dougherty passed pictures around of the current conditions of the jail to help participants understand why this project is needed. At this time, Lincoln County is licensed for 80 beds. The new jail will increase that number to 151, will allow for mental health beds, federal beds and handicap access. The location of Lincoln County is prime for surrounding areas and federal beds will bring in money to the jail that will help decrease the amount of money asked for from the General Funds. Dougherty answered questions from the participants. When asked what will happen if it doesn't pass, Dougherty answered, "if it doesn't pass, we'll keep looking. It's not a matter of if, but when."

Doolen announced that it was time to move on to the 522 Ambulance District Special Election and turned the meeting over to Billy Buchanan. Mr. Buchanan reported that since 2008, ambulance districts have been closing their doors due to Operational Costs, leaving a burden on other ambulance districts to cover larger areas. Because of the lower salary in Chandler EMS, they have lost over 90 years of experience. The funds that the 522 Ambulance District brings in will help to pay employees better and to fix equipment. Several attempts have been made through Legislation to include an ambulance fee on electric bills, but the large electric companies are opposed to this legislation. If proposal goes through, a Board will be formed to discuss how the money will be apportioned. Board members will be representative of cities and towns throughout Lincoln County.

The Commissioners returned to the Commissioner Conference Room.

Miller made a motion to approve a Resolution to set up a CDBG Grant Account for Arlington Fire. Motion seconded by Munson. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

Munson made a motion to approve FDIC Depository Agreements for Fiscal Year 2022. Motion seconded by Miller. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

Miller made a motion to designate County Clerk Alicia Waggon and Purchasing Agent Will Fine as P-Card holders with a \$7,500.00 limit per card. Motion seconded by Munson. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

Munson made a motion to approve County Lease Renewals with the following entities: Pin Drop LLC, KellPro Annual Licenses, Cannon Copier, Clean Uniform, SKT Security, Simplex/Grinnel/Johnson, Prosperity Bank, Security National Bank, Welch State Bank and Oklahoma Department of Transportation, for Fiscal Year 2022. Motion seconded by Miller. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

Munson made a motion to approve a Resolution accepting the quote of \$201,948.00 from ACCO-SIG for property and liability coverage and chose Option 1 to pay the amount in full by July 31, 2021. Motion seconded by Miller. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

Miller made a motion to adopt a new policy requiring the Board of County Commissioners to review and approve or deny OMMA Compliance Certificates in open meeting. Motion seconded by Munson. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

As advised by the Assistant DA, Randall Wiley, the Commissioners will defer action on all new OMMA Compliance Certificates until July 6<sup>th</sup>.

The Commissioners reviewed Estimate of Needs as presented by each Lincoln County office for the Fiscal Year 2022 Budget. As discussed in previous meetings, Miller asked that everyone should get a raise of equal numbers. Miller made a motion to submit Column F of the proposed Estimate of Needs to the Excise Board and to propose Executive Session for the July 6<sup>th</sup> meeting to discuss certain salaries more in depth. Motion seconded by Munson. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

Emergency Management Update: Wendi expressed serious safety concerns over an upcoming festival. She also reminded the Commissioners that she was available to offer support in the recent drug bust and encouraged them to call her if needed.
