

County Commissioners Meeting  
June 21, 2022

Lee Doolen called the meeting to order at 9:02 a.m. Commissioners Munson and Miller were also present.

Will Fire led us in prayer and Lee Doolen led flag salute.

Munson made a motion to approve the June 6 and June 13, 2022 Meeting Minutes. Motion seconded by Miller. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

Munson made a motion to approve the 6-month bids as discussed and to throw out and re-bid asphalt, tin horns, Chip & seal and Asphalt laid. Bid award sheets are available in the County Clerk's Office. Motion seconded by Miller. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

Munson made a motion to authorize application for Safe Street and Roads for All (SS4A) Grant Program. Program is a 5-year project to try to eliminate fatalities on County and State Highways. Motion seconded by Miller. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

Commissioners confirmed receipt of ARPA funds in the amount of \$3,387,224.00. The Board will discuss investment of ARPA funds at the June 30<sup>th</sup> Special Meeting. Board will discuss ARPA funds and requests for ARPA funded projects at the July 5, 2022 Commissioner's meeting.

Commissioners confirmed receipt of Minutes from the 2022 Resale of Property for Delinquent Taxes that was held on Monday, June 13, 2022.

Munson made a motion to approve 2022 Resale Property Fund Financial Statement. Motion seconded by Miller. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

Miller made a motion to approve Resolution #22-39 and Payment Option for ACCO-SIF (Workman's Comp) Insurance. Payment Option (ONE) for \$189,688 was selected and will be due to be paid before July 31, 2022. Motion seconded by Munson. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

Citizens in the Meeker Rural Water Area spoke up about their water supply concerns. A request has been made to the Board of County Commissioners to use a portion of the ARPA funds to help bring city water supply to the rural area where the water has turned salty. The property owners have to haul water in from different locations, forcing many to consider selling the property that they have sunk thousands of dollars into for their forever homes. The Commissioners will review all ARPA project requests at the July 5<sup>th</sup> meeting but can not promise approval or a timeline at this time.
