Discussion regarding payment of Emergency Services from Opioid Abatement Settlement Funds was held. The Oklahoma Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse pulled funding from Chandler's Gateway to Prevention & Recovery. In order to keep providing services in the Chandler location, discussion was held to use Opioid Abatement Settlement funds to pay May through July emergency services. Doolen asked Wagnon to bring all receipts for invoices provided by Gateway and to schedule a special meeting on Tuesday, August 12th for further discussion.


Motion seconded by Miller, Doolen, Miller and Fine all voted aye.
