Commissioner Lee Doolen called the meeting to order at 9:03 A.M. Commissioners Marlon Miller and Will Fine were also present.

Fine led the prayer and Doolen led the flag salute.

Kevin Garrett let Commissioners know the Health Inspector is here for the Jail inspection.

Miller made a motion to open Bid #26-05 Lincoln County Fairgrounds Route 66 Signage. Motion seconded by Fine. Doolen, Miller and Fine all voted aye.

Fine made a motion to approve support letter for Lincoln County Fairground's Oklahoma Route 66 Revitalization grant application. Motion seconded by Miller. Doolen, Miller and Fine all voted aye.

Amber with WSB gave estimate of 1.3 million from Rural Tribal Assistance grant to cover planning for the grant project and then apply for smaller project grant applications in the future. Just do the one project of the 50 miles as the grant project. Commissioners want to verify cost with all agreeing it should be higher and concerned if the grant would cover cost.

No Action on Resolution for District #2 to use CBRIF fund for 3470 (Sparks) Road repair. Marlon Miller is waiting on a meeting with Sac & Fox Nation to discuss.

Miller made a motion to approve Resolution #25-154 accepting \$7,601.97 donation from CenterPoint Holdings LLC for District #1 to be used specifically for road maintenance leading to their facility in Prague. Motion seconded by Fine. Doolen, Miller and Fine all voted aye.

No Road Crossings. Will Fine has been looking into agreements with the county and fiber companies. Last agreement filed in 2022 specified them fixing the road after laying fiber and it is no longer being done. Lee Doolen stated they do have a right to use statutory right of way. Marlon Miller stated they do have the right but must fix the road. They should do a Road Crossing applying the \$1,000.00 fine for each time they fail to have one. Assistant District Attorney Stacy Bateman-Woods stated they are subject to having a Road Crossing and can send letters along with invoice to the company. Marlon Miller is strongly considering not approving lay flat water line Road Crossings in District #2 due to them rolling into the road when turned on. Fine made a motion to have Assistant District Attorney Stacy Bateman-Woods send a letter to the fiber company. Motion seconded by Miller. Doolen, Miller and Fine all voted aye.

No Claims.

Ricky Taylor with WSB gave more information regarding project with Rural Tribal Assistance Grant. He explained the 1.3 million is for planning & engineering. This is just a preliminary and can't do a full plan or design. This grant will have everything ready to apply for other grants cutting the project into smaller projects of 10-15 miles at a time. Amber with WSB agreed with Ricky's statement and stated it will also cover the grant writing cost. Miller made a motion to do the 50 miles as 1 project and split into smaller projects for multiple grant applications to complete. Motion seconded by Fine. Doolen, Miller and Fine all voted aye.

Fine made a motion to award Bid #26-05 Lincoln County Fairgrounds Route 66 Signage to Encinos 3D Custom Products, LLC for \$200,767.00 for all 3 projects pending award of Oklahoma Route 66 Revitalization grant award. Motion seconded by Miller. Doolen, Miller and Fine all voted aye.

Miller made a motion to adjourn. Motion was seconded by Fine. Doolen, Miller and Fine all voted aye. Meeting adjourned at 10:05 A.M.
