

County Commissioners Meeting  
February 22, 2022

Lee Doolen called the meeting to order at 9:04 a.m. Commissioners Munson and Miller were also present.

Doolen led flag salute, Alicia Wagnon led us in prayer.

Munson made a motion to approve the February 7 and February 14, 2022 Minutes. Motion seconded by Miller. Doolen, Munson and Miller all voted aye.

Munson made a motion to approve Resolution #22-09, to purchase a Kubota Excavator from Stewart Martin Equipment (Sourcewell/SW0455) using the Use Tax Account and make payments in the self-funded accounts for District #1. Purchase price is \$72,532.22. Munson is paying \$15,000 down and paying out the remaining \$57,532.22 to the Equipment Revolving Account with 47 payments of \$1,198.59 and a final payment of \$1,198.49. Motion seconded by Miller.
