

County Commissioners Meeting
May 22, 2023

Lee Doolen called the meeting to order at 9:03 a.m. Commissioners Miller and Fine were also present.

Will Fine led prayer, Doolen led Flag Salute.

Fine made a motion to approve minutes from the May 1 and May 15, 2023 Meetings. Motion seconded by Miller, Doolen, Miller and Fine all voted aye.

Miller made a motion to approve BKL Agreement to finish design process on Lincoln County Jail Addition and Renovations. Motion seconded by Fine, Doolen, Miller and Fine all voted aye.

Miller made a motion to approve and sign ODOT Forms 324a for J/P #34441 Road Project in District 2 and Kendrick Road Project in District #1. Motion seconded by Fine, Doolen, Miller and Fine all voted aye.

Miller made a motion to close out District #3 REAP Grant, Project Pinecrest 3300 Road between 1040-1050 Road. Motion seconded by Fine, Doolen, Miller and Fine all voted aye.

Miller made a motion to approve Creek County Juvenile Justice Detention Center (CCJJC) Agreement with Lincoln County at \$85.00 per bed per day. Motion seconded by Fine, Doolen, Miller and Fine all voted aye.

Fine made a motion to approve Lease Purchase Extension Agreement for District #3. \$2,811.69 Monthly payments payable on August 22, 2023 for a maximum of 24 months. Motion seconded by Miller, Doolen, Miller and Fine all voted aye.

Miller made a motion to accept a \$75.00 donation from Patricia Cole to District #3 for a "Children at Play" sign to be placed on South Oak Park Drive in Parkwood Village Estates. Motion seconded by Fine, Doolen, Miller and Fine all voted aye.
