

**DISASTER EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION
LINCOLN COUNTY, OKLAHOMA**


WHEREAS, a historic winter storm occurred resulting in record cold temperatures for extended periods of time, and record snowfall in Lincoln County, Oklahoma, beginning February 12, 2021, causing catastrophic damages to public utility systems, stranded motorists and homeowners, significant agricultural losses, damage to county roads, bridges and other properties.

WHEREAS, immediate attention is required to protect public health, reduce further damage, insure public safety and render emergency relief; and

WHEREAS, Oklahoma Governor Kevin Stitt and President Joseph R. Biden, Jr. have declared a federal disaster for all 77 counties in the State of Oklahoma;

WHEREAS, we the Board of Commissioners of Lincoln County, Oklahoma, do find that the aforementioned conditions constitute a threat to the safety and welfare of the county, and create an emergency disaster situation within the meaning of Title 63 Section 683.3, Oklahoma Emergency Management Act of 2003;


THEREFORE, we the Board of Commissioners of Lincoln County, Oklahoma, acting under the power vested in us, do hereby declare Lincoln County, Oklahoma to be a disaster area, entitled to aid, relief and assistance and do hereby direct the implementation of the County Emergency Operations Plan.


